MRCC Elder Recommendations - Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

- What if I do not know anybody? It is okay if you do not know any qualified individual to recommend. We hope in the future you will feel comfortable participating.
- Why are some men not chosen? The elders consider those recommended and use scriptures as a guide for elders selected, some men may choose not to be an elder for personal reasons, and there may be more qualified men than can be added at one time.
- I only know one person qualified. Should I recommend one person? Yes, please recommend men who you know and are qualified. Comments about these individuals are also appreciated. Please recommend one or several qualified men.
- Can I recommend more than one person? Yes.
- I am not sure who our elders are. Where is a current list of elders? A list of elders can be found at <u>mrcc.org/about</u>.
- How old do the men need to be to be recommended? *Men need to be old enough to have believing children and meet all other qualifications required by scripture.*
- Is there a digital process for recommendations? Yes. Beginning on the first day of the selection process, the recommendation form will be available to members at <u>mrcc.org/elderform</u>. Login to the Online Community is required to complete the form.
- Where can I find the qualifications for being an elder? *Every recommendation form has the list of qualifications and scriptures for your convenience.*
- Should I speak to the individual before recommending them? It may be nice to mention to the individual that you would like to recommend them, it is not required. If you know the individual and they are qualified to be an elder, please recommend them.
- This process is overwhelming. Who can I speak to about the process? Any of the elders will be happy to address any questions you may have.
- If I recommended an individual in previous elder selection process and they were not selected to be an elder, should I recommend them again? *Yes, please recommend men you feel are qualified to be elders.*
